**Format:** **Scotch Doubles** is when *a team of two* bowlers play alternate shots throughout the game. The only time one of the pair ever completes a frame on his/her own is when scoring a strike. No Tap means that if you get 9 pins on your 1<sup>st</sup> ball; it counts as a strike.

**NOTE:** Teams will receive a handicap based on either their current bowling average or, for non-league bowlers, a default average of 120 for students under the age of 18 and the ladies and 150 for the men.

**Cost:** \$25 per team includes 4 games of bowling per team, snacks and a cash bar. (\$5 Student discount will apply if both team members are under the age of 18).
